In 2010, Shane Haddad was diagnosed with brain cancer. Shane's parents, Amy and Eric Haddad, understand the challenges that families face when you have a child with cancer. With this thought in mind, Eric and Amy decided to create Shanerock, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Shanerock focuses on supporting local families who are battling pediatric cancer and other non-profits who support the fight against pediatric cancer.
